The Feeding of the 5,000

Some time after this, Jesus crossed by boat privately to a solitary place on the far shore of the Sea of Galilee (that is, the Sea of Tiberias), and a great crowd of people followed him on foot because they saw the miraculous signs he had performed on the sick. Then Jesus went up on a mountainside and sat down with his disciples. The Jewish Passover Feast was near.

When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. He began teaching them many things about the kingdom of God and healed their sick.

As evening approached, the disciples came to him and said, "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late. Send the crowds away, so they can go to the surrounding countryside and villages and find food and lodging."

Jesus replied, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."

He said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?"

He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do.

Philip answered him, "Eight months' wages would not buy enough bread for each one to have a bite! Are we to go and spend that much on bread and give it to them to eat?"

Jesus then took the loaves, looked up to heaven, gave thanks, and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.

When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves and fish left over by those who had eaten.

"How many loaves do you have?" he asked. "Go and see."

Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"

Jesus said, "Bring them here to me, and have the people sit down in groups on the green grass." There was plenty of grass in that place, so they sat down in groups of hundreds and fifties. There were about five thousand men plus women and children.
